At Ferring, your privacy is important to us and we are committed to ensuring our data protection practices adhere to applicable European and local national data protection regulations.

This Privacy Notice will provide information as to how Ferring may collect, hold and process your personal data, and will describe the ways in which we will ensure your personal data is protected in accordance with the applicable regulations.

What is personal data

Personal data means all information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual. This may include name, email address or any other information which may be used to identify you personally such as your company and your job title

Who can be considered as a data subject

A data subject is any identified or identifiable individual about whom personal data is being processed. If you are not already a data subject of Ferring, there may be opportunities during your visit to this website and your registration to the Webinar series held by Ferring whereby you provide personal data voluntarily, and

therefore become a data subject. Ferring will only collect personal data from you during your visit and your registration and participation to the Webinars if and when you voluntarily provide it.

How Ferring may use your personal data

Ferring International PharmaScience Center (IPC) ("Ferring"), as the data controller, on behalf of affiliates of the Ferring Group will only process your personal data where there is a legal basis for doing so, and where it is necessary to carry out the purpose for which it was collected. The legal basis for processing your personal data will depend on the purpose for which the data was collected, as described below:

- Personal data may be processed if necessary for our legitimate interests in pursuing or fulfilling the following purposes:
 - to respond to you regarding an inquiry in the following categories: media; partnerships; development of business relationship; and any other general enquiries;
 - to process and respond to enquiries regarding data privacy and your privacy rights;
 - to process and respond to a collaboration request; or
 - any other legitimate business purposes such as data analysis, audit, improving services and expanding our business activities.

Ferring believes it necessary to process personal data for the purposes mentioned above based on legitimate interests to ensure that enquiries, requests, applications, and reports are timely processed in line with users' expectations, policies and applicable laws, while at the same time adequately considering your rights. In addition, you can obtain more information about the legitimate interest balancing test that Ferring has performed.

- Personal data may be processed when necessary to comply with applicable laws and regulations such as:
 - to comply with laws within or outside your country of residence,
 - to comply with a legal process or in response to a court order to produce certain personal data.

Your personal data will only be used for the specific purpose for which it was collected and will not be used for any other purpose without notifying you in advance and/or obtaining the appropriate consent.

Cookies

When you visit this website for our Webinar series, data about your use of the website may be collected using Google Analytics. This tracking technology uses cookies to collect aggregate data about website usage and activity, such as how many users visit the website and how often. This data may be shared with the third-party(website) service provider namely LogMeIn Inc., in order to further improve our web services. Retention of personal data

Ferring will follow the appropriate actions to ensure your personal data is retained only for the period required to fulfil the purposes outlined in this Privacy Notice. Ferring will only retain personal data for a longer period if required or permitted by law or by applicable regulations within the pharmaceutical industry.

Your rights

If and when we collect, hold and process your personal data, you will be afforded specific rights as a data subject. Ferring will give effect to these rights in accordance with the applicable European and local national data protection laws.

- Right to access and rectification: you have the right to request a copy of the information we hold about you, as well as the right to request the correction of the personal data we hold if it is inaccurate.
- Right to erasure and restriction of processing: you have the right to request the erasure of your personal data or for the restriction of processing your personal data. These rights are limited and will apply only in certain circumstances and where no exemptions apply.
- Right to data portability: you have the right to request a copy of the personal data we hold, as well as the right to request this data be transferred to another controller. This right is subject to certain conditions and may not apply, for example, if not permitted for reasons of public interest, or is not technically feasible.
- Right to object: you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data. If the data is processed for reasons of public interest, scientific or statistical purposes, you may still object and it will be our responsibility to demonstrate the legitimacy of processing the data.
- You have the right to contact or lodge a complaint with your local data protection supervisory authority.

In addition,

- you can always unsubscribe at any time from direct marketing by clicking on the "unsubscribe" or "opt-out" link in the emails we send you, and

How Ferring may transfer or share your personal data

Your personal data may be transferred to other locations in which Ferring maintain facilities (including Ferring affiliates, contractors, partners or agents), where there are legitimate grounds for such a transfer, such as a valid business reason. Such locations may include countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA). Any such transfers will be safeguarded by internal international data transfer agreements, to ensure that your personal data is protected in accordance with the applicable European and national data protection laws.

Ferring may, in certain circumstances, share your personal data with third parties, such as vendors, contractors, partners or agents, if necessary to achieve the notified purposes, or if such third parties are assisting Ferring with the processing of the data. In our case, by being registered via (<https://www.gotostage.com/channel/2c11dcc101d8469f929389b5ca6a4e56>) your personal data can be transferred to LogMeIn Inc, which as a service provider that assists Ferring with the processing of the data via this website. Ferring will only disclose personal data about you to a third party in the following circumstances:

- Relevant consent has been provided by you;
- where applicable, as a result of a request by you as a data subject
- whereby there is a legal basis for the disclosure of the data and you have been provided with suitable notice of this
- where we are required to do so under applicable laws or as a result of a court order; or
- where Ferring decides to sell, buy, merge or otherwise reorganise its business structure.
- Ferring will never sell your information to a third party.
